Checked Baggage

Enjoy one of the most generous baggage allowances in the world. Our free baggage allowance is based on either the total amount of weight or on how many pieces of luggage. This is called the weight or piece concept. Emirates Skywards Platinum, Gold, or Silver member, could also enjoy extra baggage allowance on routes that use the weight concept. When traveling on piece concept routes on Emirates flights only, Emirates Skywards Platinum and Gold members are eligible for 1 additional piece of checked baggage at 23kg (50lb) per piece in Economy Class and 32kg (70lb) per piece in Business Class and First Class over the ticketed limit.
