

# International Route Network Update

Dear Trade Partner,

As you may be aware, the evolving situation in parts of the Middle East has led to airspace constraints and operational adjustments across the region.

In response, Air India is currently operating a reduced flight schedule on select routes, while continuing to closely monitor developments and align operations with the latest regulatory and airspace advisories.

We remain committed to supporting our travel partners and ensuring minimal disruption for passengers during this period.

Despite the challenges and beyond these adjustments, Air India will continue to operate more than 1200 international flights every month, retaining a robust international network that spans five continents, including 33 flights per week to North America, 47 flights per week to Europe, 57 flights per week to the UK, 08 flights per week to Australia, 158 flights per week to the Far East, Southeast Asia and SAARC regions, and 07 flights per week to Mauritius (Africa).
