



## Changes effective July 2026

**Dear travel partners,**

The following changes to seat selection and checked baggage policies are effective beginning July 2026. For any questions or inquiries, please contact your Key Account Manager.

### **Economy Standard**

#### **Seat selection on domestic & regional routes**

**Starting July 7, 2026**, the seat selection policy in the mid and front cabin will be subject to the same seat pricing across the entire Icelandair fleet.

Currently, passengers are able to select their seats free of charge in the mid and front cabin on routes operated by De Havilland 200 (DHC200) and De Havilland 400 (DHC400) aircraft, which includes domestic intra-Iceland, Faroe Islands, and select Greenland flights.

# Saga Premium

## Seat selection on international routes

**Starting July 21, 2026**, seat selection on Saga Premium fares is subject to a fee. Passengers who do not select a seat at the time of booking will be allocated a seat without a fee during check-in.

*Note:* Seat selection on Saga Premium *Flex* fares will remain included in the fare.

## Checked baggage allowance on international routes

**Starting July 21, 2026**, the number of checked bags included in Saga Premium fares changes from two to one. Currently, two checked bags with a maximum weight of 70 lbs (32 kg) each are included. The new policy includes one 70 lb. (32 kg) checked bag.

*Note:* The checked bag allowance on Saga Premium *Flex* fares will remain at two 70 lb. (32 kg) checked bags.

## What happens to the tickets booked before July 21, 2026?

All reservations booked before July 21, 2026, need to be ticketed before that date to retain the same benefits and conditions that applied at the time of booking. Changes to these tickets will follow the same rules that applied on the date of purchase.
