we would like to inform you that for the coming winter season, **starting from 15 November 2026, the Rome Fiumicino–Buenos Aires (FCO–EZE–FCO) route will be operated with 10 weekly flights instead of 9 .**

Specifically, a third flight on Sundays will be added to the existing schedule of two weekly flights on the AZ682/683 daytime service on Tuesdays and Fridays.

The schedule for the Rome Fiumicino–Malé (FCO–MLE–FCO) route will also be increased for the coming winter season .

From mid-January 2027, the service will increase to 4 weekly flights in January and 5 in

February and March.

Convenient connections are guaranteed across the entire ITA Airways network.

We would like to inform you that, starting from **15 July 2026** , a **two-factor authentication (OTP)** verification will be required when modifying **Frequent Flyer** and **contact information** (**FQTV, CTCE, CTCM**) through the **Manage My Booking** and **Online Check-in** services on the ITA Airways website.

The OTP code will be sent to the customer by email and has been introduced to enhance data security.

The OTP verification will not be required for logged-in passengers who :

- have a basic Travel ID account;
- hold Frequent Traveller, Senator Member, or HON Circle Member status.

We therefore **kindly ask you to pay particular attention when entering passengers' email addresses and phone numbers** in the PNR.

From 25 October to 11 November 2026, runway refurbishment works at Buenos Aires Ezeiza Airport (EZE) will result in operational restrictions.

The direct FCO–EZE service will continue to operate, but with a reduced capacity of 233 seats instead of 319. The EZE–FCO service will operate via EZE–GIG–FCO, including a technical stop in Rio de Janeiro (GIG).
