



Expansion of IRBS to LAX and SEA Routes

Effective **June 24**, U.S. CBP's **International Remote Baggage Screening (IRBS)** has been expanded to Korean Air's **LAX** and **SEA** routes.

Passengers connecting to U.S. domestic flights can now enjoy a seamless transfer **without the hassle of claiming and re-checking luggage** at their first port of entry.
