All passengers can access the onboard Wellbeing Zone, a dedicated space for movement and premium refreshments, designed to optimise wellbeing throughout the flight.



High-speed Wi-Fi

Passengers in all cabins can enjoy access to complimentary high-speed Wi-Fi and Bluetooth connectivity across their devices.



First

The enclosed First suite has 50% more suite space than our A380, with a 22" wide reclining armchair, a separate 80" (2m) long flat bed and 32" entertainment touchscreen (14" larger than the A380).



Business

The Business suite features 47" high walls with a sliding door for added privacy, an 80" (2m) long flat bed (1" longer than those found in the A380 First suites), and an 18" entertainment touchscreen (2" larger than those in the A380 and B787).

First

The A350 will feature six spacious, enclosed First suites, each designed using the latest in textile innovations and ergonomic design to create the ultimate luxury travel experience. The suites feature a flat bed and separate reclining armchair, with a large flexible work and dining space for one or two people. A full-length wardrobe can also be found in each suite, along with several areas for personal storage.

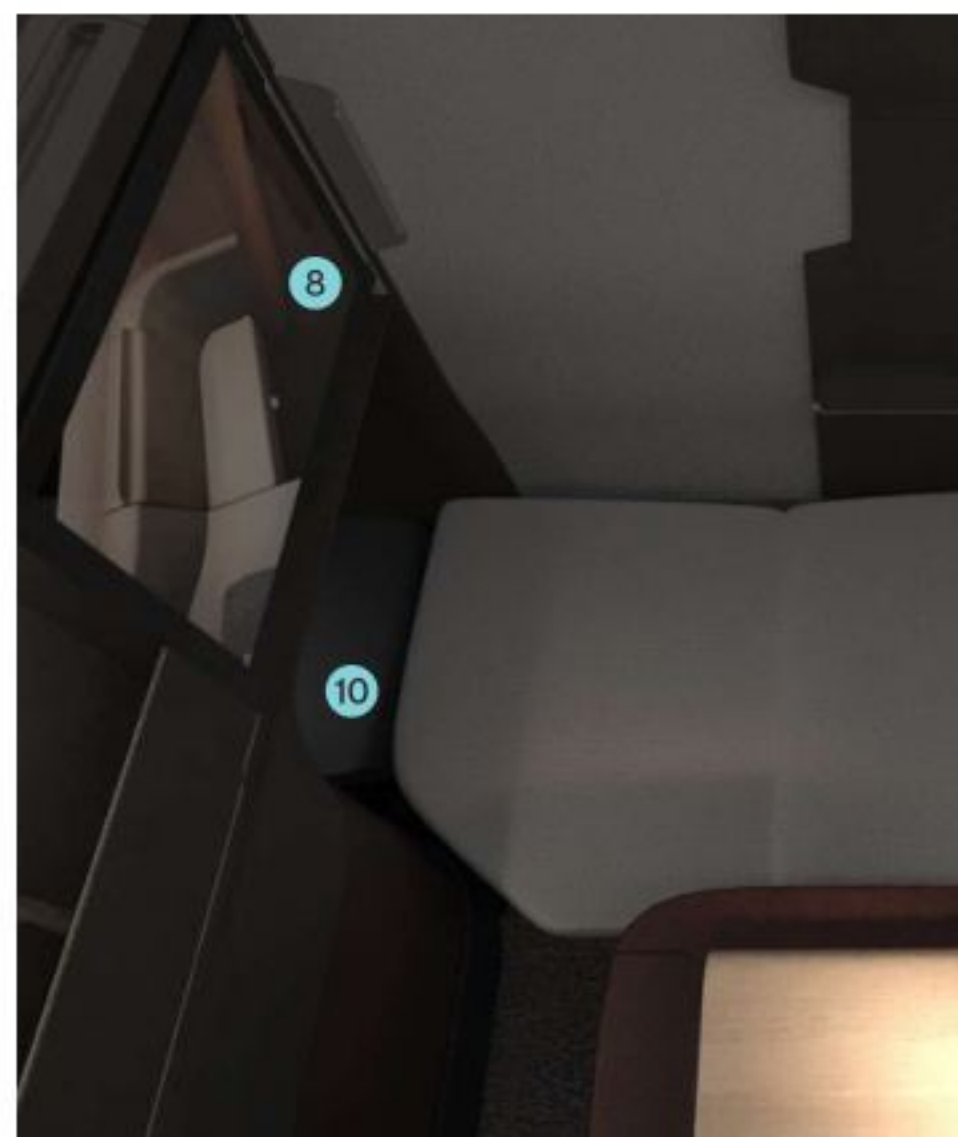

For the first time, Qantas Business suites will feature a sliding door for additional privacy, as well as an adjustable divider between the alternating centre seats. Complete with a large dining table and work surface, increased storage options, the suite features innovative design and materials to deliver exceptional inflight comfort.
