AIR INDIA EXPANDS SERVICE TO CANADA FOR WINTER SEASON WITH NEW TORONTO-MUMBAI FLIGHTS, BEGINS OPERATING BRAND-NEW B787-9 ON TORONTO-DELHI FLIGHTS

- New seasonal Toronto-Mumbai service with upgraded cabin interiors
- Brand-new cabin products on Toronto-Delhi flights
- 100% new or upgraded product deployment from Toronto from January 2027

TORONTO, August 1, 2026: Air India today begins deploying its brand-new B787-9 aircraft on Toronto-Delhi flights, bringing the airline's all-new cabin product and onboard experience to Canada for the first time and significantly elevating passenger experience.

Building on this milestone, Air India announced the expansion of its Canada operations for the Winter 2026-27 season with:

- A new non-stop service between Toronto and Mumbai
- Overall capacity between Canada and India increasing by 4,400 seats each month
- Premium seat capacity from Toronto boosting by 71%

New, seasonal Toronto-Mumbai service with upgraded interiors

Air India will launch a seasonal **3x weekly non-stop service between Toronto and Mumbai** between **October 25, 2026 and March 26, 2027**, adding nearly 2,000 seats each week between Canada and India and making it the only carrier operating direct flights between the two cities.

The service will be operated by Air India's **Boeing 777-300ER aircraft with significantly upgraded cabin interiors**, featuring 8 luxurious First Class suites with privacy sliding doors, 40 flat beds in Business Class, and 280 seats in Economy.

Travellers between on this route will also enjoy WiFi internet connectivity on board the upgraded B777-300ER aircraft.

Through Air India's hubs at Mumbai and Delhi, customers travelling from/to Canada can connect seamlessly to destinations including Ahmedabad, Amritsar, Bengaluru, Chandigarh, Chennai, Hyderabad, Kochi, Ludhiana, and Vadodara, among several other Indian cities.

100% new or upgraded product deployment from Toronto from January 2027

Of the 10x weekly flights Air India operates on the Delhi-Toronto route this Winter, 7x weekly services will be operated by the brand-new Boeing 787-9 aircraft, featuring the airline's latest cabin products. The remaining 3x weekly services will be initially operated by Boeing 777-300ER aircraft and will **transition to the new Boeing 787-9 from January 2027** as more aircraft join the fleet.

With that, all Air India flights to and from Toronto will feature all-new or significantly upgraded cabin interiors, delivering a consistent premium experience across the market.

The deployment of the new and upgraded aircraft from Toronto to Delhi and Mumbai enables Air India to **boost premium seat capacity to Toronto by 71%** this Winter, offering more First Class, Business Class, and Premium Economy options to travellers.

Nipun Aggarwal, Chief Commercial Officer, Air India, said: "Canada is one of Air India's most important international markets, with deep people-to-people connections driving strong demand for travel, particularly during the festive and holiday season. The launch of our seasonal Toronto-Mumbai service this Winter will provide travellers more choice and convenience at a time when many are travelling to reunite with family and friends. At the same time, we are also progressively introducing our newest aircraft and the latest onboard products to North America, reflecting our intent to put our best foot forward in one of the world's most competitive long-haul markets. Together, these initiatives mark another important step in our journey to make Air India a world-class airline and the preferred gateway between India and the world."

In the 2026-27 Winter season, Air India will operate a total of 20 flights each week from Canada to India, including 10x weekly from Toronto to Delhi, 3x weekly from Toronto to Mumbai, and 7x weekly from Vancouver to Delhi.

PLEASE NOTE

- Wi-Fi plans can only be purchased onboard, once the aircraft has reached an altitude of 10,500 ft or above.
- Each Wi-Fi purchase is valid for one device only for the duration of that session. To connect multiple devices, a separate Wi-Fi plan must be purchased for each device.

- A Wi-Fi plan cannot be changed once purchased. A new plan may be purchased on the same device after the original plan has expired.
- Voice and video calls over the internet are not permitted and are blocked in accordance with Air India policy.
