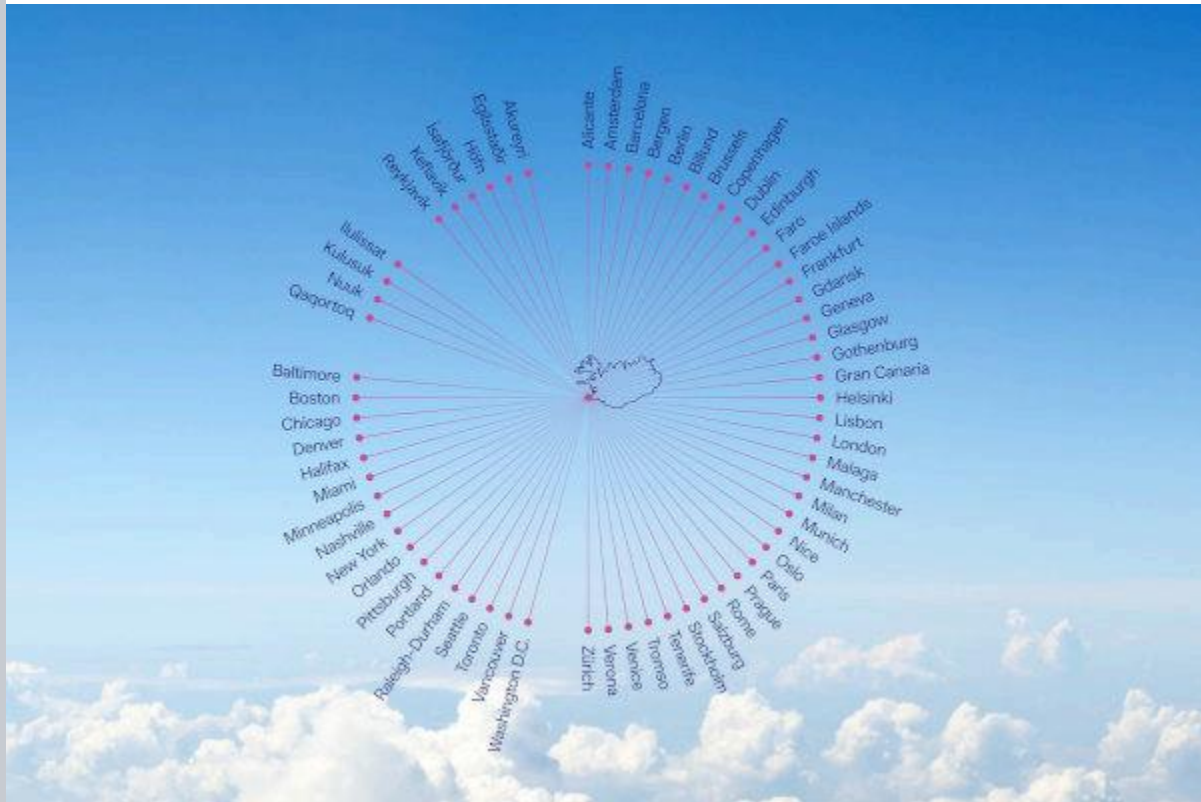




Icelandair's newest destinations

Tromsø, Norway

Flights begin October 22, 2026

Icelandair's third destination in Norway! One of the world's northernmost cities, Tromsø (in Norwegian: Tromsø) sits over 200 miles above the Arctic Circle and pairs dramatic northern landscapes with a lively cultural scene.
